

White Bluff Resort Evacuation Policy

In the event that White Bluff is subject to a mandatory evacuation order, local and county fire/law enforcement officials will carry out that task. A Telephone Notification System call (TNS or “reverse 911”) should go out to every home with a recorded message informing all of an emergency situation. If sufficient time allows, members of the White Bluff staff will drive prescribed routes warning every house on property utilizing bullhorns and loud speakers of the need to leave.

The primary evacuation route will be White Bluff Drive, through the front gate to FM 933. If the nature of the emergency is such that that primary evacuation route is impractical, all three of the emergency exits marked on the attached map will be open. Every effort will be made to inform you of the nature of the emergency and the best exit strategy.

In the event of flooding which renders the White Bluff Drive covered bridge impassable, all emergency exits will be opened.

Please understand that the local and county officials are in charge of any mandatory evacuations and will have the most current information and guidance for evacuation. Once local officials are on scene, White Bluff staff will assist as directed by the local on-scene commander.

PLAN AHEAD!

We recommend you maintain an emergency kit and have an evacuation plan, to include arrangements for any pets or animals kept on your property. Familiarize yourself with all routes from your residence to all of the emergency exits.
