

**DRIVING DIRECTIONS FOR THE  
ENNIS BLUEBONNET TRAILS SPONSORED BY ENNIS GARDEN CLUB  
MARCH 28- APRIL 3, 2017**

**BLUEBONNET STATUS:** The bluebonnets in Ennis are looking good! Estimated peak for entire area of Ennis is about the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> week to 2<sup>nd</sup> week of April but stay tuned to [visitennis.org](http://visitennis.org) or [bluebonnettrail.org](http://bluebonnettrail.org) for photos & updates! Some areas will peak ahead of others.

**PLEASE NOTE:** These directions are written from Ennis Convention and Visitors Bureau, (Ennis Visitor Center) located at 002 East Ennis Ave., Ennis, Texas 75119. **THESE ARE DRIVING TRAILS! PARK ADDRESSES: Ennis, Texas 75119-**

**These directions are written from WEST, to SOUTH, to NORTH TRAIL but you can drive them in any order.**

**REVISED MARCH 28, 2017:**

**WEST TRAIL:** Turn (R) on E. Ennis Ave from Ennis Visitor Center, travel West on Ennis Ave. & take (L) on Ennis Pkwy (Veterans Memorial Park, 2301 Ennis Parkway.) Continue & cross the 287 Bypass and turn (L) at stop sign. Bluebonnet Park- 201 S. Hwy 287, is on the right. Turn (R) out of the park, travel on Hwy 287 and take the Hwy 34 exit. Turn (R) on Hwy 34, then right onto Laneview (last right before crossing the lake). Go to Meadow View Nature Area-1901 Laneview Dr. **MUST SEE!** Return to Hwy 34 and turn (L) and travel East on Hwy 34 to **SOUTH TRAIL:**

**SOUTH TRAIL:** Travel east on Hwy 1181 (Creechville Rd) 251A off of IH-45) and turn (L) on Cody Road, (L) on Old Telico Rd., (R) on Loneoak then (L) on Hwy 34. Turn (R) on Hwy 660 to **NORTH TRAIL:**

**NORTH TRAIL:** (R) on Hwy 660 North to Union Hill at **CRISP.** Travel on Union Hill to Andrews Rd. Turn (L) on Andrews and take a (L) on Slate Rock and a (L) on Stacks and take a (R) on FM 660. Take a (L) on Sugar Ridge Road to FM 813. Turn (R) on FM 813 to return (L) on FM 879 or (R) to FM 813 back to IH-45.
